1	Value chain and support process areas	The value chain and support process areas represent the top level in the potential abstraction hierarchy of enterprise activity. Value chain areas directly impact the product or service a customer consumes. The activities that comprise a value chain process area are typically operational in nature, as opposed to support.
2	Non-primitive process areas	A process area which, when decomposed, will yield lower-level process areas.
3	Primitive process areas	The lowest level process area. A primitive process area represents a grouping of enterprise activity entirely focused on one class of business object (i.e., customers, suppliers, accounts receivable, etc.) and any dependent object classes. Further decomposition of a primitive process area will yield elementary processes.
